# Brief report on schools sessions

Terry Caldwell reported that on Wednesdays approximately 17 students from Albury High School attend the sessions with a couple of Keenagers volunteering to assist. On Thursdays there are approximately 30 students from James Fallon High School and Bruce Cowan assists Terry Caldwell at these sessions.

### Issue with toilets often being clogged

Terry Caldwell raised concerns about toilets being clogged after recent sessions. Session Coordinators to be asked to check toilets before locking up.

#### Wednesday evening session arrangements

Discussion was held about options for sessions to be offered on Wednesday evenings going forward, given the low numbers participating and late cancellation of recent sessions. Decided that it was preferable to offer an open session for training and/or general practice subject to sufficient demand and the availability of session leader/s.
